It was created by two Americans called Perls and Satir in order to collect answers to questions and opinions. It is linked to psychotherapy and can be applied in any field, whether personal or professional.

The NLP can help us commercially, incrementing sales by perfecting the way we negotiate and the way in which we lead. It helps develop emotional competencies that serve to reach an effective communication, see how the other perceives reality, understand body language, to perfect communication techniques, and by doing so, we can influence others. You also learn to expose clearly and acquire precision in messages to avoid distortions.

It serves as a technique to generate a good rapport that is a connection or tuning with the client thus, they will have more opportunities to offer and ask about a product. It works effectively with the "visual client", meaning those that see or visualize images in their mind, allowing them to order and process all the information properly.

This technique is useful to apply. For example, in a commercial meeting where the products or services are displayed to the client, it is necessary to identify the kind of public that one will have or anticipates to put the exhibition into practice, it is logical not to be delivered to where the people will not pay you the attention you need, This factor can be changed or anticipated by creating an environment of kindness and interest with the listeners.

For this method to work, we must take into account these steps:

1. Each word or action generates a reaction: some actions or words cause negative or positive thoughts in people, causing an impact.
2. Take care of the way you refer to yourself: when speaking with others you need to generate confidence in yourself, increase your security.
3. Eliminate the NO from your vocabulary: while it takes experience, you will eliminate the negativity from your mind and replacing it with a 'if you could'

4. Body language: a good contribution to speak well and achieve good speech is greatly influenced by posture and gestures.
