Ecuador is considered the most enterprising country in all of Latin America, which is a great advantage for the Ecuadorian population as it helps with the future economy. The demographics of the country's entrepreneurs show that 52.85% are under 35 years old, 68.1% if they finished school, 65.9% come from the urban area and 34.1 from the rural area. In 2017 there were a great number of adult entrepreneurs, three million joined for a march to publicize new projects that at the end were very successful inside and outside the country, giving us a great opportunity for Ecuadorian talent to be noticed.

The monograph was divided into three chapters: Chapter I Youth and Entreprenurship, Chapter II Entrepreneurial Benefits and Chapter III Young Ecuadorians Entrepreneurs.

Chapter I

Youth and Entrepreneurship

1.1 Young Entrepreneurs

In recent years, young people are becoming more and more enterprising, the people

between 18 and 24 years old think that if they create their own business will have a good laboral life and a business career its one of the best and influential careers in this last decade and, besides, this age group is higher than those of the 28 and 35 years old group.

Cervantes (2016) affirms:

Older youth are about 1.4 times more likely to be involved in a nascent activity and also in a new entrepreneurial activity, compared to younger youth. From each country's point of view, young people in Ecuador are the most entrepreneurial, while in Spain they are the least entrepreneurial.

In the country lately there have been a lot of businesses created by young people that have been very successful. Normally you see cafeterias, clothing stores, fast food restaurants, etc, so they can have more youth clientele, they also create a social network page to have more recognition.

To explain this topic you can see an experience of Luis Loayza (2016) "We went from work in my room to an office in the center of Guayaquil although we had to share it with some lawyers. Our staff reached 10-15 people(...)" (p.81).

Among all latin American countries all young entrepreneurs are more inclined to be owners or managers of a company, for example between Brazil and Ecuador the young people serve more for owners than managers, but in Panama the percentage is lower than the countries mentined before.

1.1.1 Mark Zuckerberg.

Mark Zuckerberg, programmer and entrepreneur, was born on May 14, 1984, is recognized for being the creator of Facebook, a very revolutionary social network



worldwide since 2004, Zuckerberg is named as one of the most influential people in our society due to everything he has brought us since the beginning of his entrepreneurial career.

He grew up with his jewish family, his father, Edward Zuckerberg, was a dentist and his mother, Karen, was a psychiatrist but she dropped out when she had four more childrens. His parents hired a private teacher to teach him more about computers because Mark was developing a lot of interest in computers.

Mark, in addition to be one of the most innovative people in the world, is also admired for his wealth and yet is a humble and simple person, for example, everybody knows that he wins millions and millions of dollars thanks to facebook and yet he always wear basic t-shrits and jeans and live in a simple room with some friends.

Torres (2008) refers that when Mark Zucherberg was only 24 years old he was within Steve Jobs, Larry Page and Bill Gates reach, every single person around the worls was very impressed by this man that create a very revolutionary social network with a very hard impact in actual youth.

1.1.1.2 Mark Zuckerberg collage education.

His high school education start in Ardsley high school but time later his parents realized that he had a higher intellectual capacity than the other kids of his age and they decided to change him to a private school called Phillip Exeter Academy in New Hampshire.



In the academy of New Hampshire he practice a lot of fencing and thanks for all that practice he could become the captain of the team, winning more recognition inside the academy and outside too, but he always prefer all the world of technology because that was his passion.

In 2002, he applied at for Harvard University and was gratefully accepted for his amazing intelectual and creativity, then in Harvard started facebook with two other friends.

Zuckerberg at Harvard was known for his experience in developing software programs and then he created a website for students to choose their courses called CourseMatch, and he created FaceMash too, this website cause him a lot of problems, the university directors considered very inapropriated because it was based in compare students.

Zuckerberg's company is named as a new internet door, Torres affirm us: "Mark mentioned Englad and Australia where the largest comunities were in MySpace but then they switche to Facebook" (p.4).

Chapter II

Entrepreneurial Benefits

2.1. Steps of development

Being an entrepreneur brings many advantages, and sets a good example for the young people of our society, for example, creating your own business makes you a more responsible person, independent, creative and among many other features.

Being an entrepreneur makes you an innovative person, your projects can make a big change in today's society, an entrepreneur always has an easy path to their own ideas, which help you make your future projects are unique.

The term project comes from the Latin projectus and has several meanings. "A project refers to an articulated and coherent set of activities aimed at achieving one or more objectives, following a methodology, (...). (Beltrán, 2011, p.12).



2.1.1 How an entrepreneurship project is generated?

An entrepreneurial project can arise in several ways, for example, brainstorming between partners can be very useful as there are two heads or even more generating ideas for a future project; actually there's not just only one method for creating a project as long as it is feasible and practicable can be accepted in our society.

For brainstorming there are some key steps so that good to emerge a great idea for your company, the duration is something very important but can not exceed 30 minutes, so you will have a lot of ideas and will make it difficult to choose one.

Do not judge the ideas of any colleague because, although the ideas are not very creative, can be very helpful to complement them and thus build an idea that can make a lot of help for your future business.

For the ideas that are generated with your team, quality is not taken into account but the quantity, the more ideas you have is better because this way the key idea that will make your company succeed can arise.

The number of participants for your company, which in other words would be called partners, are the basis of the creation of the company, because the ideas and everything a company needs will be provided instantly, but it is recommended that the number of participants be between 4 to 6.



Beltrán (2011) affirms:

It is suggested that a brainstorming session be held to enable the emergence of an idea that is according to various factors that go through the knowledge of the business, product, market, even for the taste to perform a certain activity and that have to be viable for financing. (p.14)

2.1.2 Characteristics of a viable idea.

There are three principal characteristics for generate a project, first of all you need to have some understanding of the idea that is being raised, then you have to know the cost of your project to know if you are economically able to create it or to be able to know which work is convenient for you to earn enough money and finally the idea you generated has to be recognized or easy to understand, in few words, that is within our environment.

2.1.3 Mission of a company.

The mission of a company is based of what you are gonna do inside the company, the description of the values and priorities that you, as an entrepreneur, will give to your clients. This part of making your own company its really essential because the employees, the first thing that they search before working in your company, its what is your purpose with them.

Many times in homes, when parents talk to their children about work or how it was previous years, usually say phrases like "I should have done that" or "I would have done better if I had done that", in some ways it is good to tell your children so they do not make



the same mistakes but it is also wrong because you are teaching them to complain and that lowers much to their motivation.

3.2.1 What universities have to do to encourage them

Schools and universities are very helpful incentivizing the students to like entrepreneurship because of the projects and contests that they make them do to increase their creativity and make some seniors who still don't know which college career to pursue clear their minds with all these activities that schools do for them with those kinds of problems.

(Zavala, 2014, p.52)

Zavala (2014) refers that the Guayaquileños prepare very well inside the university in the entrepreneurial careers becoming later professionals because they require all the tools that an entrepreneur needs.
